## The Elements of Squeeze Play

## Constituents of a Squeeze

1 A Squeeze is a card play device in which an opponent is forced to release one of two (or more) controls enabling you to gain a trick, an entry or to avoid a loser.

2 You must have at least two threats against the same opponent
3 One of the threats must be accompanied by an entry - either in the same suit (a linked threat) or in the suit of the other threat

4 You must have no surplus losers outside the threat suits
5 The Squeeze Card (SQC)is the last winner to be cashed outside the threat suits and is the trick which causes the squeeze to take effect.

## What you need to be able to do

1 Recognise Threats
2 Visualise Ending Patterns
3 Plan the play to reduce to the required ending pattern

4 Cash all winners in the threat suits in advance except those needed to provide entries.

## Simple Squeeze Requirements

1. Two threats against the same opponent
2. At least one of the threats must be in the hand opposite the squeeze card
3. There must be an entry to that threat and that entry must be in one of the threat suits
4. You must have no losers left outside the threat suits

## The UNLINKED THREAT

1 An unlinked threat is a card of losing rank in which one opponent holds all cards higher in that suit.

2 You do not have a winner either accompanying the threat or in the hand opposite.

3 It is often necessary to play off surplus winners or losers in the threat suit to isolate the threat against a single opponent.

4 The simplest example is a King against the opponent holding the Ace

## The LINKED THREAT

1 A linked threat is a threat accompanied by a winner with a link card opposite to provide an entry.

2 A threat must be linked when it is opposite the squeeze card and the other threat is an unlinked threat

3 Simplest example is AQ opposite a singleton against an opponent holding a guarded King.

## The DOUBLY LINKED THREAT

1 A doubly linked threat is a threat accompanied by a winner with a link card in both hands.

2 This type of threat may be needed in cases in which you have an unlinked threat opposite the squeeze card.

3 Simplest example is $\mathrm{A} \mathrm{J} \times$ opposite a $\mathrm{K} x$ against an opponent holding a twice guarded Queen.

## The SPLIT THREAT

1 A split threat is a threat accompanied by a link to a winner in the opposite hand. The winner must be accompanied by a small card to provide the link back to the threat.

2 This type of threat is needed in cases in which your other threat is an unlinked threat opposite the squeeze card and you have no doubly linked threat available

2 Simplest example is Ax opposite a $\mathbf{Q} \times$ against an opponent holding a twice guarded King.

## The BLOCKED THREAT

1 A blocked threat is a threat accompanied by a link to a winner in the opposite hand. The winner is not accompanied by a small card.

2 This type of threat is needed in cases in which your other threat is also a blocked threat in the other hand.

3 Simplest example is $\mathbf{Q} \times$ opposite a $A$ against an opponent holding a twice guarded King.
4 A squeeze with two mirrored blocked threats is called a CrissCross Squeeze
